Palmer Electric tapped for 30-story downtown Orlando mixed-use building

WINTER PARK, FLA. – August 11, 2006 – Palmer Electric Co., the longest continuously operating electrical contractor in Central Florida, has snagged the sought after contract to wire the 30-story Dynetech Centre, a mixed-use building located at 121 E. Washington Street in the heart of downtown Orlando, Fla. Project general contractor, Brasfield & Gorrie, LLC., chose the Palmer team for site and building electrical contracting, including the interior finish work on the office, apartment and amenities components. Ground floor retail is also called for in the \$80 million project. Completion is scheduled for September of 2007.

“Our team is geared up and ready to go on this exciting addition to downtown,” said Tom Beard, President of Palmer Electric. “This building is destined to be a landmark in our community,” he added.

Designed by the Orlando, Fla. office of Baker Barrios Architects, the high-rise building, totaling 600,000 square feet, boasts 160 rental apartments, 150,000 square feet of office space, an eight-level parking garage, a roof top pool and 13,000 of retail space. Lincoln Property Co. is the project’s developer.
