Palmer Electric Wiring Mixed-Use High-Rise

WINTER PARK, FLA., June 27, 2007 – Palmer Electric Company is providing general contractor, Jennings Construction Services, LLC, with design assist services for the electrical contracting, low voltage, telephone, TV, card access and data systems for 101 Eola, a 424,000-square-foot downtown Orlando high-rise. The 12-story, mixed-use building is part of a planned two building complex. Along with 15,000 square feet of ground level retail space and three levels of structured parking, 101 Eola has seven floors dedicated to 146 residential condominium units, a pool and clubhouse. Completion is planned for the end of 2007.

The developer is Real Estate Inverlad, a local group building this project under the corporate name, B.A. Jackson Street Condominium, LLC. This same development, design and construction team has worked together before completing The Jackson, a nine-story condominium building in downtown Orlando, in April 2006.

Two Orlando-based firms provided design; Baker Barrios Architects is the architects of record with Ingenuity Engineers handling the electrical engineering.
